1. Say where an animals lives

When scientists say an animal species is endangered, it's like a big, flashing, warning sign: Danger! Something is very wrong here!

There are almost 400 endangered animal species in the USA. Here are 10 examples.

1. Polar bears live in Alaska.
2. The buffalo lives in western prairies.
3. The desert tortoise doesn't live in Texas but in California.
4. Gray wolves live in Montana, in the North West of the USA.
5. The Sierra Nevada red fox lives in California.
6. Eastern indigo snakes don't live in Massachusetts but in Florida.
7. Whooping cranes, the tallest north American bird, spend winter in Texas.
8. The mountain yellow-legged frog lives in California.
9. The Pallid sturgeon lives in the Missouri and Mississippi rivers. This fish doesn't live in lakes.
10. Melissa blues are butterflies. They live in New England.
